Representative Payee Services



Q How can Residential Opportunities, Inc. (ROI) help?

A For most people, paying bills and maintaining a budget is a necessary inconvenience. For some, especially people with developmental disabilities, addictions or mental illness, it may be a huge barrier to the necessities and comforts of life. Representative Payees can help overcome this barrier. At ROI, our Representative Payees manage the finances of over 200 people, helping individuals and their families every day. Responsible budgeting and timely payments means fewer worries and more peace of mind.

Q Who is eligible?

A Our Representative Payees are authorized by the Social Security Administration to provide money management to individuals who receive monthly Social Security benefits – such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments. Anyone who receives Social Security benefits and needs help managing their money may be eligible for a Representative Payee.

Q What is a Representative Payee?

A A Representative Payee will help you create a budget that works with the money you receive each month. Then we pay your bills and make sure you have money for food and other necessities. Making sure you or a loved one has shelter, food, clothing, and medical assistance is our priority. If you have money left over, you get to decide if you want to save or spend it. All money that is saved is deposited into a bank savings account and earns interest. Your Representative Payee will keep track of your savings and let you know if you need to spend some in order to stay eligible for government benefits.
