We will be a model program for providing state-of-the-art autism treatment in the Great Lakes region.



Qualifying for Services

The Great Lakes Center for Autism - Outpatient Services (GLC) accepts most commercial insurance plans and works closely with the Community Mental Health (CMH) system.

If your child has an autism diagnosis, the first step is to contact your insurance provider to confirm coverage for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy.

If your child has not been diagnosed yet, we recommend starting with a visit to your primary care provider to discuss any developmental concerns. Your provider can help you begin the diagnostic process.

Once your child has a confirmed autism diagnosis and the insurance coverage is verified, simply give us a call to begin the intake process or schedule a tour!

The Great Lakes Center for Autism - Outpatient Services (GLC) provides individualized Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services throughout Southwest Michigan. We specialize in supporting children and adolescents diagnosed with autism, from 12 months to 21 years of age.


Early Intervention (ages 12 months - 6 years):

- Focuses on communication skills
- Builds foundational skills to meet developmental milestones
- Encourages social and play skill development
- Increases skills for school readiness
- 30-40 hours a week recommended

Individual Sessions (ages 6 - 21 years):

- Personalized therapy for school-age children and adolescents
- Focus on behavior management, independent life skills, and social skills
- Daytime and after-school sessions to fit your family's needs
- 10-30 hours a week recommended

At GLC, we highly encourage families to observe sessions and participate in parent coaching sessions. Our Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs) and Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs) strive to establish a therapeutic relationship with the families we serve and are dedicated to providing compassionate, evidence-based care.



Other Outpatient Services Available

Social Skills Sessions

GLC offers fun, age appropriate groups for children and teens. These groups focus on building friendships, learning to work within a group, and strengthening communication and social skills.

Parent Coaching Sessions

Our Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs) provide personalized one-on-one support for caregivers to learn practical tools, ask questions, and feel more confident navigating challenges at home, school, or the community. These can occur individually without the youth receiving center-based services.
